The 12th AVS meeting will be held in December 2024. The meeting will provide a relaxed forum for the virology community to share their research and to help foster collaborative opportunities. Most importantly, the meeting will provide a supportive environment for the next generation of virologists, students, and post-docs.

The conference will be held at the **RACV Goldfields Resort**, located in the heart of Victoria's gold rush landscape and in the historic bushland around Creswick.



AUSTRALASIAN VIROLOGY SOCIETY

The Australasian Virology Society aims to promote, encourage, support and advocate for the discipline of virology in the Australasian region.

The society was incorporated in 2011 after 10 years' operating as the Australian Virology Group (AVG), founded in 2001.

AVS began as a regular biennial meeting, the aim to provide a national forum and opportunity for those with interests in human, animal, plant, or prokaryotic virology to meet and discuss wide-ranging issues from basic molecular virology to ecology, disease, diagnosis, and control.

This meeting is now a regular feature of the Australasian virology calendar. The meeting in 2024 will be the 12th meeting held.

ATTENDEE PROFILE

AVS meetings attract 200-250 delegates from across Australasia which represent a diverse group, including established virologists, clinicians, representatives of funding bodies and regulatory agencies.

After 20 years our meetings showcase the latest and best in virology from researchers spanning the spectrum from PhD students and ECRs to established virologists.

AVS members serve on influential bodies such as the Australian Government's Gene Technology Advisory Committee, the Therapeutic Goods Administration advisory committees, virology diagnostic experts, local research ethics committees, and committees of the major funding bodies, the National Health and Medical Research Council and the Australian Research Council.

There will also be strong representation from the local Infectious Diseases clinical and diagnostic community.


